Last Spring, Maria Miller, MSW brought her social work skills to the IFAC as case worker assisting IFAC Director Renee Bryant and volunteers in serving neighbors in need. Maria brings a caring heart and sensitive professionalism to our work. In June, after 23 years of serving older adults through the ADC, Charles Treston, BS retired. On staff since its opening in 1990, Charles provided compassionate care to participants and provided guidance and leadership to countless staff through the years. FCHUM bestowed the status of Emeritus Staff to Charles in honor of his dedicated career. Also in June, FCHUM gathered together to observe our 25th anniversary date with a summer food drive and facility blessing celebration. Please visit our website and Facebook to see more details. On July 1st, after 10 years of "temporarily" serving as both ADC Director and Executive Director, I was finally able to pass the baton of ADC Director to Cicely Chandler, MSW. We are delighted to have her join our team and look forward to many years of service together. Now, as we enter autumn, it is the season to think about our Holiday Cheer program, to eat chicken on the first Sundays at St. Ignatius, to prepare for festivals such as the Highview Community Fall Festival, church festivals, & FCUMC Burgoo Festival on October 12th. It is time to prepare for the Highview Holiday Fest, Love Lights, and our Christmas benefit concert at TWOC. I invite you to join FCHUM's efforts as we strive to be instruments of compassion to our community.

5,650 food items were collected in our **Cans for Kids** Summer Food Drive, as well as an additional \$426 in donations. This was a great help in our food pantry during the lean summer months. St. Stephen Anglican was #1 in the per capita amount with 663(all protein) items and SHUMC was #1 in the overall amount with 1210 items. Eleven churches participated in the event. **TRILOGY HEALTH SERVICES's** Glen Ridge campus collected 605 pounds of food items and \$1,789.07, the Franciscan campus collected 426 pounds and \$4,745.76. Total from these two Trilogy facilities for this summer is 1031 pounds of food items and \$6,534.83. On Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, Steve Bays of Summit Heights United Methodist, held a benefit concert. 93 pounds of toiletry items were collected as well as \$267.02. Thanks to all who helped fill the shelves this summer.




