Last year FCHUM celebrated its 25th anniversary, last year one of our churches celebrated their 100th anniversary. This year one church is celebrating 50 years, another 60 years of service and worship. These are significant events, milestones, passages along our journey. 

Holiday Cheer Program 2014.

Holiday Meal Items:

Stuffing Mix, 1-5 lb. bag of potatoes, 1-3 lb. bag of onions, 2 cans of cranberry sauce, 3 to 5 cans of green vegetables (green beans, peas, etc.), 3 to 5 cans of mixed vegetables (corn, yams, etc.), 1 to 2 cans of pie filling, 1 bag of flour and 1 bag of sugar, \$15-\$20 gift certificate to buy meat/perishable items

Suggested Christmas Buying Guidelines

A. 1 to 2 outfits per child (Not to exceed two): Example:1 pair of pants, (jeans, etc. or skirt), 1 shirt or sweater, socks and undergarments, Please note if a child has a special need!

B. 1 to 2 age appropriate gifts per child

C. (Optional) a gift for parent
