In May, I celebrated my 19th anniversary of ministry here with FCHUM. Starting in 1996 as ADC Director and then accepting the role of Executive Director in 2003. We have accomplished much during this time. Not the least was the building of our facility and being debt free. I was deeply honored on June 12th, to receive the ElderServe 2015 Champion For Aging Award. For those of us in the Aging services field here in Louisville, this is somewhat like receiving the Academy Award's Lifetime Achievement Award. It was humbling to be recognized for many years of service, but as I noted in my acceptance remarks, "This is not something accomplished without help. I am not the Lone Ranger. I have been blessed with the teamwork and assistance of many, many colleagues and supporters." While these anniversaries, accomplishments, and awards may seem like having reached the mountain top, I see significant opportunities waiting ahead as FCHUM approaches its 30th Anniversary in 2018. Most importantly, I think of our Legacy of Caring Sustainability Project: Investing to Serve. We have just passed the \$70,000 mark toward our goal of \$250,000. If we can reach this goal by our 2018, 30th anniversary, the monthly dividends will be make us independent from the costs of operating our physical facility. From then on the only funding we will need will be for programming only. We hope that YOU will discover an opportunity, within these pages, to join us in this and other endeavors.
